Re: Advice / Recommendations from the OGC Advisory Committee

The Advisory Committee held its quarterly meeting on March 12th and 13th, 2007 in Fort St. John. The following represents a summary of the Committee's advice and recommendations to the Oil and Gas Commission as a result of discussions at this meeting:

Verification of Landowner Notification

- ⇒ The Advisory Committee has discussed the COR process, particularly the requirement to notify the landowners. The Committee recommends the OGC ensure that there is direct verification that this has been done.

Communication

- ⇒ The OGC develops a communication plan that addresses the issues that affect the residents of north east British Columbia. The Commission should consider a coordinated effort with MEMPR, CAPP as well as the Canadian Centre for Energy Information.

A Summary of the Advisory Committee's meeting is attached for your reference. These minutes elaborate on the discussions that culminated in our advice and recommendations to you. The recommendations brought forward in this correspondence shall be referred as Mar 07 R⁰¹.and Mar 07 R⁰².
